2012 Area 11-L Spring Referee Requirements/Deadlines

- The “target” is to have 3-person neutral referee coverage for all Spring Games.
- Each Region (which includes Region 84) will need to develop a referee support point system/plan for each team participating in the Spring 2012 program. Any team that does not meet the point requirement will be ineligible to participate in any post Spring season tournaments.
- The Region’s support point system will need to be posted on their website for all to review.
- Referee support/coverage is the responsibility of the home Region/home team. Where a game involves two (2) teams from the same region referee support/coverage is the responsibility of the home team.
- Referee parents will not be permitted to act as a Referee (center) for games that involve their own children's teams. Said parents should not sign up for AR positions on such games, unless last minute help is needed to have a 3 person referee team covering a game. The Regional referee management is responsible for ensuring compliance.
- Games that do not have a Referee (center) assigned as of 9:00 PM on Thursday (for a Saturday game) or 9:00 PM on Friday (for a Sunday game) will be cancelled by the Area Director/his designee. During the seeding round of the season, said cancellation will be reflected as a "game not played." During the medal round of the season, games cancelled due to lack of referee signups will result in a forfeit on the part of the home team (recorded as a 1-0 victory by forfeit for the opponent/visiting team). **Any games “cancelled” during seeding and/or medal rounds due to lack of referee coverage will NOT be rescheduled for ANY reason.**
